EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

- Overall, it can be said that more seats are in favour of YSRCP in Kadapa, Rajampet, Nandyala, Kurnool, Tirupati, Araku and Vizianagaram districts and that the rest of the districts are in favour of the alliance.
- In terms of social groups Reddy, Muslim, SC Mala, Christians and a section of OBCs are in favourof YSRCP party while social groups like Kapu, Kamma, Yadava, Vaishya, Madiga and some OBCs are in favour of grand alliance.
- It can be said that there has been some opposition to the formation of districts in some places.
- It must be said that people do not have a positive opinion on three capitals.

Factors that are positive for YSRCP:

- It can be said that the Government was successful in taking welfare schemes to the masses.
- Areas represented by majority SC constituencies are strongholds for the party.
- Party has recovered some ground after the TDP-JSP alliance with BJP.
- It must be said that the preparatory meetings of the party have raised enthusiasm among the people.
- It has to be said that the party was successful in impressing people through the volunteer system.
- Opinion of the people towards the availability of village secretariats is very positive.
- It should be said that the welfare schemes have gone to the people during
- Changes in candidates in some constituencies turned out to be positive for the party.

Factors that are negative for YSRCP:

- There is a feeling of opposition to YSRCP government among the farmers. It is heard that farm machinery tools and subsidies have not reached many farmers.
- There are more than 30,000 pastors in the state who are dissatisfied due to the lack of salaries and the lack of proper structure for negotiations.
- In the matter of unemployment, the YSRCP government failed and people are going to other states because there are no companies in their own state.
- Government employees are not paid their salaries on time and they are dissatisfied.

- Traders and builders are also protesting against high prices of commodities and sand problems. They are worried that high prices of construction have become a burden on them.
- It must be said that there is no positivity towards the government even among the private employees.
- Public opinion is expressed that no steps have been taken towards development in the state.
- It must be said that Sharmila's presidency of the Congress party is also likely to cause some trouble for YSRCP.
- It is said that there is a feeling of antipathy among the people on the free availability and consumption of ganja.
- Land grabs and law and order problems in some areas are also causing insecurity among the people.
- It must be said that some schemes like Amma Odi, YSR Asara Houses for all the poor as part of Navratnaluhave raised hope initially. As the number of beneficiaries have been dropped from 100% to 65%, it has decreased the confidence in the YSRCP government.
- It must be said that new corporations have been formed in the state and nominated posts have been given to the cadre from the lower to the higher levels. But the non-allocation of funds has caused dissatisfaction among the own cadre.
- Non allocation / diversion of funds of village panchayats has caused dissatisfaction among the sarpanch and ward members.
- Administration errors are heard strongly. People have expressed that administration is responding only to the ruling party cadre and not to the common people.

Factors that are positive for TDP Alliance:

- It can be said that the last MLC elections in the state gave life to the party.
- It can be said that after Chandrababu Naidu went to jail, public sympathy has been expressed for him.
- Manifesto introduced by TDP is also positive in the eyes of public.
- Yuvagalam padayatra has raised enthusiasm in the party ranks.
- Combination of TDP plus Jana Sena has expressed good positivity among the people. However, there is a different opinion about the combination of BJP.
 But slowly the alliance is gaining ground.
- There is an opinion amongst the people that there will be development only if there is a grand alliance.
- Majority of the Kapu voters in Kona Seema area are in favour of TDP alliance.

- It must be said that people are welcoming the decision taken by TDP in the matter of Amaravati capital.
- Upper class, middle class and neutral people are positive towards TDP.
- Majority of the people strongly felt that roads and development were done only when they were in power.
- Madiga Community is positive for TDP alliance due to support of Popular Madiga Leader Shri MandaKrishna Madiga.

Factors that are negative for TDP Alliance:

- Alliance with BJP has made TDP-JSP somewhat weaker than before. It is expressed by the people that the contestants in the seats allotted to BJP are not strong enough.
- Sharing of 10 assembly seats and 6 parliamentary seats with BJP having 1% vote bank is a minus for the alliance.
- In the firstPraja Galam Sabha of NDA, different opinions were expressed by the people on Modi as he has not given any assurance to the state.
- It is expressed by the public that Janasena is not as active as before after seat sharing.
- It must be said that there is some gap in addressing the affected candidates due to seat sharing.
- It has to be said that in some places, dissatisfaction has been expressed over giving chance to the YSRCP leaders who has been joined in TDP, recently.
- It is heard that the party is not paying much attention in rural areas and slum areas.
- It must be said that there is some flaw in YCP's conversion of affected sections towards the party
- It should be said that there is still no consensus in some constituencies regarding the seats of the alliance candidates.
- In SC constituencies YSRCP is much stronger than TDP.

What Poll Pulse Says on the outcome of the forthcoming election:


- ✓ According to the survey conducted by Poll Pulse Survey Organization in the state, more than 78 thousand samples were taken from March 2 to April 12. It can be said that the new government is in favour of coalition with 98 to 104 seats.
- ✓ There is a high possibility that YSRCP will get from 54 to 60 seats and there is a high competition in the remaining 23 seats. In any case,
