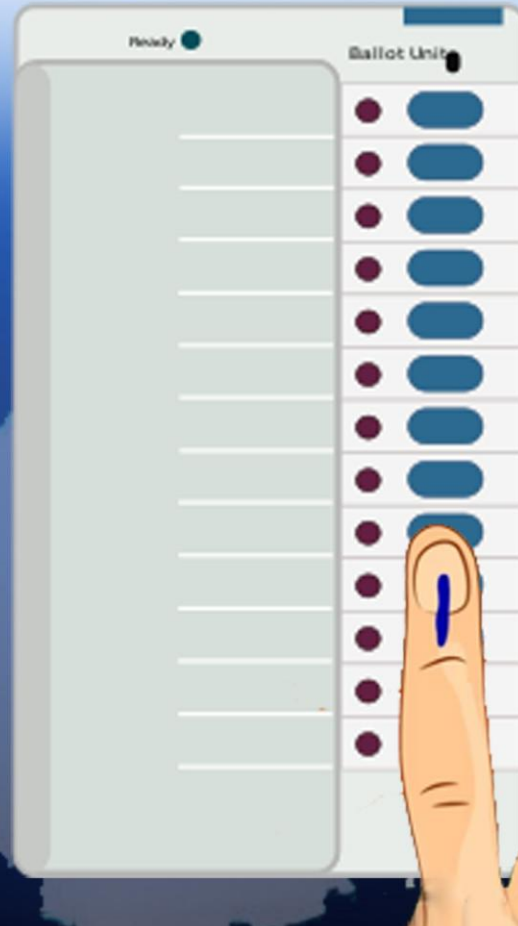
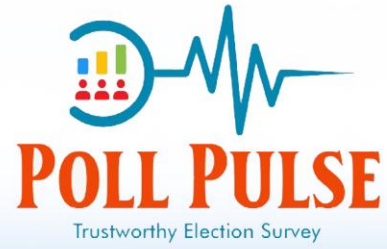

2024 ANDHRA PRADESH ELECTIONS – POST POLL OBSERVATIONS:

- TDP won 23 seats in 2019 and it is likely to win 95% of the same constituencies in 2024.
- Large percentage of people are dissatisfied with lack of development, liquor and sand policies, high prices, increase in electricity charges, law and order, and disorganized systems in the state.
- Pawan Kalyan's influence worked well in erstwhile North Andhra, Godavari, Krishna and Guntur districts.

- Allegations are being made that even the leaders of YSRCP are embarrassed by YSRCP government due to non-payment of the bills.
- YSRCP has given competition in some constituencies by shuffling the candidates.
- TDP alliance and YSRCP equally competed in poll management.
- To some extent, in few constituencies money factor led to huge voter turnout.
- It can be said that most of the employees and postal ballot votes were in favor of the TDP+JSP+BJP alliance.
- It should be said that majority of Reddy, SC Mala, ST, Muslim minorities, and Christian minorities voted in favor of YSRCP. Majority of Kapu, Vaishya, Brahmins, Kamma, BCs, OBCs, and SC Madiga voted in favor of the alliance.
- It should be said that the unemployed youth, businessmen, contractors, private and government employees, farmers, upper class, above middle class, middle class, and neutral voters formed a majority vote bank in favor of the alliance.
- It can be said that unemployed youth, IT employees, private employees, and businessmen of Andhra Pradesh origin living in other states are inclined towards the alliance.
- It should be said that volunteer system, village secretariat employees, people from backward regions, nominated cadre, and lower middle-class people have majority preference in favor of YSRCP.
- Assembly seats with a slight edge have shifted more in favor of the alliance.
- Increase in voting percentage turned more in favor of the alliance.
- YSRCP is likely to gain majority of SC and ST constituencies.

Specific Observations:

- 72.4% of farmers are against the land titling act.
- 66.8% are unhappy about the development.
- 62.6% did not support three capitals.
- 58.4% are unhappy with the administration, and law and order in the state.
- 65.5% felt that Alliance manifesto is good.
- 83% of postal ballots voted in favor of TDP+JSP+BJP alliance.
- 72% of government employees voted in favor of the Alliance.
- 71% of private sector employees voted in favor of the Alliance.
- 65% of non-resident AP people voted in favor of the Alliance.
- 68% of business communities voted are in favor of NDA.

Final Conclusion:

According to the survey conducted by poll pulse survey organization post poll in the state random sample size **36 thousand** samples were taken from the **May 13 to May 31** which there may be 2% - / + error.

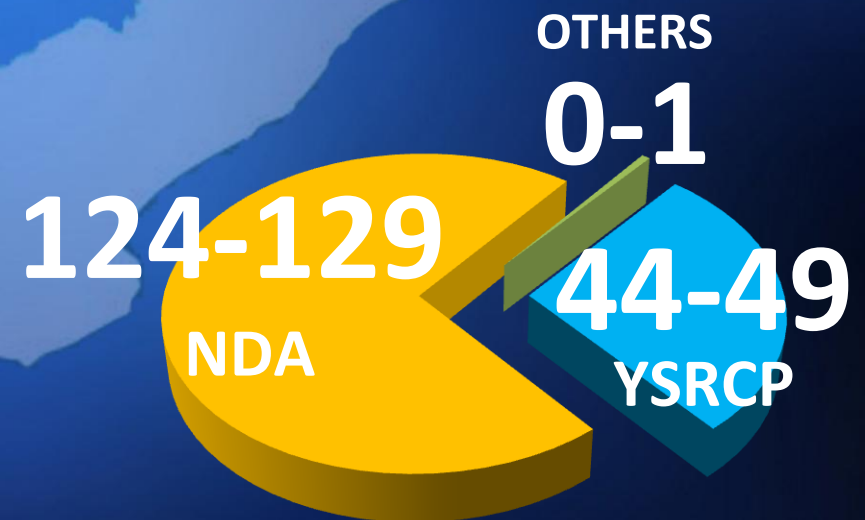
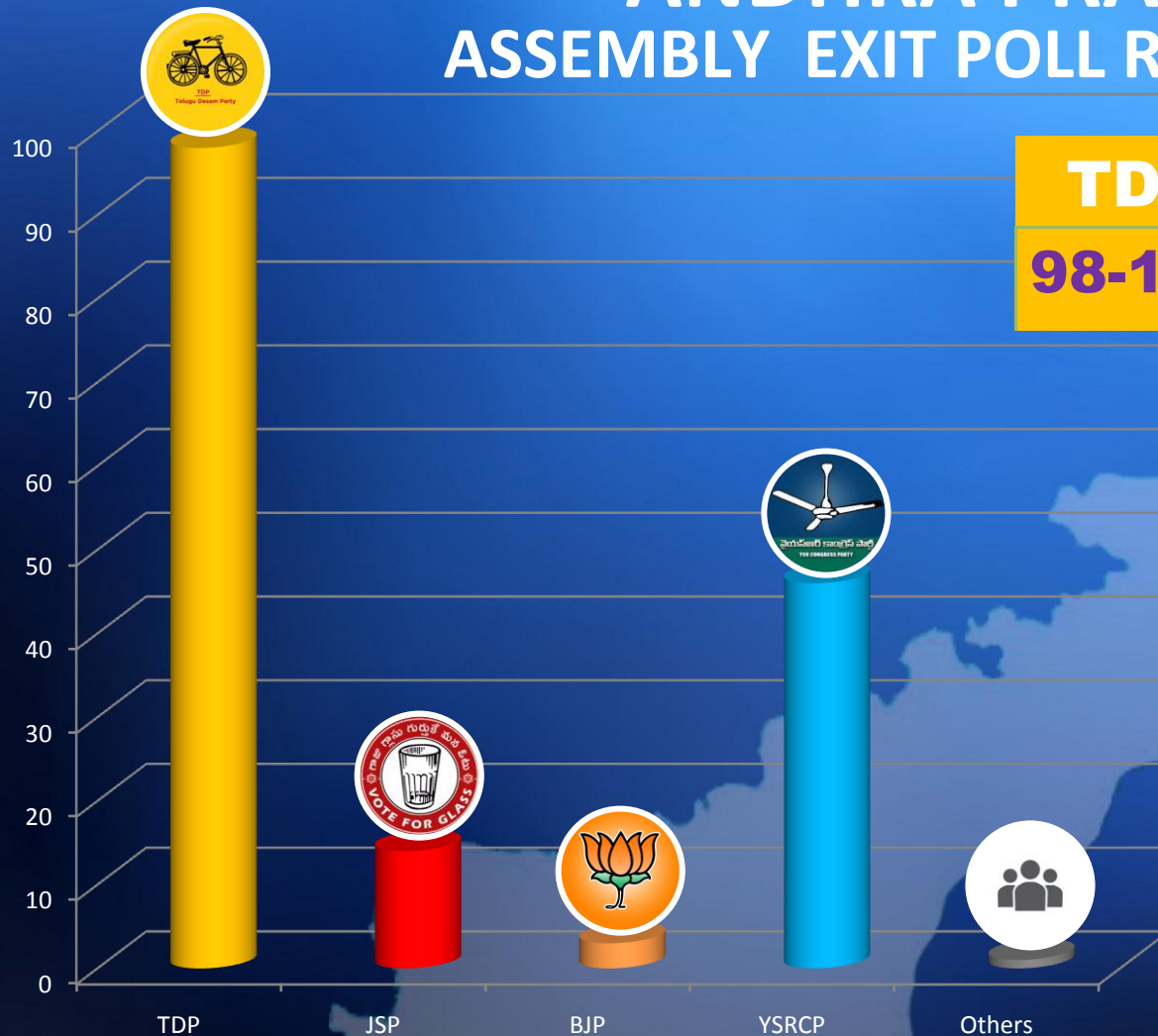
It can be said that the new government is in favour of **TDP+ JSP+BJP with 124 to 129 seats**.
